Supporting documents required to be submitted with exchange application	
	1. Curriculum Vitae (Croatian or English)
	2. The Learning Agreement (signed by the student and home institution, preferably checked by host faculty/academy). Obligatory before submitting: student can enter only courses that are available at the receiving faculty/academy. Receiving institution in OLA is always the faculty/academy to which you are applying, NOT THE UNIVERSITY OF ZAGREB! In OLA - for UNIZG, the "Contact Person" at the Receiving Institution is International Relations or ECTS Coordinator, and the "Responsible Person at the Receiving Institution" is ECTS Coordinator (person responsible for signing OL
	3. Transcript of Records (issued by the student's home university)
	4. Certificate of Enrolment (issued by the student's home university)
	5. Scan of the ID card (both sides) / Passport (first page with the photo and personal data)
	6. Copy of the ID card (both sides) / Passport (first page with the photo and personal data)
	7. Proof of English knowledge if you are following courses in English – B2 level (Accepted language tests are: official confirmation of language instructor at the home university on university letterhead with original signature and stamp/seal TOEIC 700 (Oxford Campus : TOEIC 750) TOEFL IBT 79 - CBT 210 IELTS 6.0 Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE)

If university-administered accommodation is not available, will there be any assistance in finding private housing?	<p>Housing</p> <p>International exchange students can choose between two housing options: living in a student residence hall or private accommodation.</p> <p>Student residence hall</p> <p>Exchange students coming to Zagreb may choose between organized accommodation in one of the 3 student halls of residence or a private rental. The University of Zagreb does not guarantee student accommodation. Students who decide to seek accommodation in the student halls of residence need to apply for it. The housing request form is part of the general online application form for exchange students.
